2023-2024 Cost of Attendance for JDInteractive Students

The College of Law provides an estimate of costs a student should anticipate while enrolled in the JDInteractive program. The chart below provides estimates for directly billed tuition and fees (figures 1-3) and cost of living estimates for the fall 2023 and spring 2024 semesters.

Tuition for students enrolled in the JDInteractive program is charged on a per-credit-hour basis. The tuition rate for fall 2023 and spring and summer 2024 is \$2,150 per credit. Residencies are a requirement of the JDInteractive program; the residency fee covers materials, costs associated with speakers and events, food costs and other miscellaneous expenses.

For figures 4 - 9, please take into account your actual and expected expenses for the fall and spring semesters which span from mid-August 2023 through the first week of May 2024. These estimates are provided to guide in the development of a cost-of-living budget and in total, should not exceed the maximum cost of attendance.

Additional expenses may be considered by the College of Law Financial Aid Office with proper documentation. Examples of allowable types of expenses include the one-time cost of purchasing a computer for the program or childcare expenses.

Expenses NOT allowed in the educational budget include consumer debt (ex: credit card payments), the purchase or upkeep of your automobile, costs associated with finding employment (interview expenses, clothing), and expenses incurred during periods of non-enrollment.
