

PRENUPTIAL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 14th day of February, 2013, by and between West Whitton (hereinafter "Whitton") and Avery Addison (hereinafter "Addison"). In consideration of the mutual agreements and representations contained in this agreement, the parties agree as follows:

ALIMONY AND SPOUSAL SUPPORT WAIVERS: Both parties forever release each other from any alimony or support obligation now and in the future, no matter how their circumstances may change, and they will not apply for alimony or support now or in the future. Both parties waive any rights they may have to proceed against the other under any law or statute for payment of alimony or support, and rely on the law of contract to govern this issue. Both parties realize that their respective financial circumstances may be altered in the future by changes in their health, cost of living, employment, marital status or otherwise. No such change will give either party the right to seek support under any legislation, federal or state law. Both parties understand that this agreement represents a final disposition of all alimony and support issues between them. Both parties affirm that they have the capacity and intention to support themselves financially and maintain their respective lifestyles independently, and believe that this provision is fair and reasonable under the circumstances.

SEPARATION, DIVORCE AND INFIDELITY CLAUSE: Both parties affirm their commitment to a faithful and monogamous marriage, and acknowledge that trust and fidelity are vital to the success of the marriage. In the event that Addison files for a legal separation or divorce, or engages in a sexual relationship, romantic relationship or goes on a date with a third-party outside the marriage, as a consequence, Addison shall forfeit any rights to claim the separate property of Whitton, including but not limited to personal property, real property, businesses, bank accounts, financial assets, investments, securities, stocks, bonds, annuities, and all other assets, and Whitton shall retain the sole ownership and control over such. Both parties agree that Addison shall have no claim on any property or assets Whitton acquired prior to their marriage, including but not limited to personal property, real property, businesses, bank accounts, financial assets, investments, securities, stocks, bonds, annuities, and all other assets, and that ownership shall remain with Whitton. Both parties agree that any and all property or assets listed above will not be subject to division or distribution, including any marital property acquired jointly during their marriage and shall not be subject to equitable division. Both parties agree that they are aware of the equitable distribution laws of the State of New York, and it is their intention that the equitable distribution laws will not apply to the ownership, interest and division of this property, jointly or separately owned, nor to their future property owed by either one or both of them. Both parties agree that it is their desire and intent to contract out of the equitable distribution laws of the State of New York, and to make a full and final settlement of all matters of property, both real and personal, previously and presently owned by either of the parties or to be acquired by either of the parties in the future.

NEW YORK LAW SHALL APPLY: The parties intend for this agreement to become effective upon their marriage, pursuant to the laws of the State of New York. Both parties agree that the distribution of property that either or both of them may own, will be governed by the terms of the agreement and any statutory or case law that may apply to them, either by virtue of federal or state legislation, will not apply to them.

VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT AND INDEPENDENT COUNSEL: Both parties did execute this agreement voluntarily, without undo influence, and agree that this agreement was not unconscionable when it was executed. Prior to the execution of the agreement both parties were provided a very reasonable disclosure of the property or financial obligations the other. Both parties agree that they have sought out the advice of independent legal counsel, and confirm that they fully understand the legal consequences of this waiver of alimony and support, and all other agreements and waivers made herein.

NON-TERMINATION AND FULL AGREEMENT: Both parties agree that this agreement will continue upon their legal separation or termination of the marriage, whether by death, divorce or otherwise, and agree that this agreement constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties to this agreement.
